1. Introduction

Welcome to itemis Solutions Cloud. Your privacy is important to us, and we are committed to protecting your personal data in compliance with applicable laws and regulations, including the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR).

This Privacy Policy explains how we collect, use, and protect your personal data when you use our **itemis Solutions Cloud SaaS Service** ("Service"). By accessing or using the Service, you agree to the collection and use of your data as outlined in this policy.

2. Data Controller

3. Types of Data We Collect

We may collect the following types of personal data:

4. Legal Basis for Processing Data

We process your personal data based on the following legal grounds under the GDPR:

- a. **Consent**: When you provide explicit consent to process your data for specific purposes (e.g., marketing communications).
- b. **Contractual Necessity**: To fulfill the terms of the contract between you and itemis AG, such as providing access to the Service.
- c. Legal Obligation: To comply with legal obligations, including regulatory requirements.
- d. **Legitimate Interests**: For business purposes, such as improving the Service and ensuring security, provided that such interests do not override your rights and freedoms.

5. How We Use Your Data

We use your personal data for the following purposes:

- a. **Providing the Service**: To allow you to access and use the Service.
- b. Customer Support: To respond to your inquiries, provide technical support, and improve our services.
- c. **Communication**: To send you important updates about the Service, including administrative messages, account notifications, and marketing communications (if you have opted in).

- b. **Legal Obligations**: We may disclose your data if required to do so by law, regulation, legal process, or governmental request.
- c. **Business Transfers**: In the event of a merger, acquisition, or sale of assets, your personal data may be transferred as part of the transaction.

7. Data Retention

We will retain your personal data only for as long as necessary to fulfill the purposes outlined in this Privacy Policy, or as required by law. This includes the duration of your subscription to the Service and for a reasonable period afterward in order to comply with legal, regulatory, or contractual obligations.

8. Your Rights

As a data subject under the GDPR, you have the following rights regarding your personal data:

- a. Right to Access: You have the right to request access to the personal data we hold about you.
- b. Right to Rectification: You have the right to request the correction of inaccurate or incomplete data.
- c. **Right to Erasure (Right to be Forgotten)**: You can request the deletion of your personal data, subject to certain limitations.
- d. **Right to Restriction of Processing**: You can request that we limit the processing of your personal data in specific circumstances.
- e. **Right to Data Portability**: You have the right to receive your personal data in a structured, commonly used format and to transmit it to another data controller.
- f. **Right to Object**: You can object to the processing of your personal data, especially in cases where we process it based on legitimate interests.
- g. **Right to Withdraw Consent**: If we process your data based on consent, you may withdraw that consent at any time.

9. International Transfers

We take the protection of your personal data seriously and implement appropriate technical and organizational measures to safeguard it. However, no method of data transmission or storage is 100% secure, and while we strive to protect your personal data, we cannot guarantee its absolute security.

11. Cookies and Tracking Technologies

We use cookies and similar technologies **solely for technical purposes** necessary to ensure the proper functioning and security of the Service. These cookies are essential for enabling core features such as authentication, session management, and system stability. We **do not use cookies for analytics, advertising, or tracking users across websites**. As these cookies are strictly necessary for the operation of the Service, they do not require user consent under the applicable EU laws (e.g. ePrivacy Directive, GDPR).
